1 Corinthians 15

Sermon Notes:

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### PREPARATION

To gain the most from this study, we recommend that you prayerfully ask God for direction and use a formal translation [e.g. ESV, NASB, NKJV].

### OBSERVATION / INTERPRETATION

Please read 1 Corinthians 15:1-28 before beginning this study.

#### THE GOSPEL [15:1-11]

Observe *the overview* of the gospel (vv 1-2):

- What does the gospel do to you?
- What must you do for the gospel?
- What is the instrument of the gospel?

Observe *the components* of the gospel (vv 3-8):

1. Who died? \_\_\_\_\_ Why? for our \_\_\_\_\_

3. Who was raised? \_\_\_\_\_

4. To whom did He appear?
